

INFORMATION FOR HUNTERS

We ask that your hunting party reads the following information and adheres to our procedures in order to remain safe, help operations run smoothly and also to ensure hunting sites remain clean and tidy for others to enjoy.

We appreciate that **many of you have flown before** **BUT** ask that you still follow our procedures:

- Follow **ALL** instructions given to you by your Pilot,
- Please only allow Pilot to load/unload aircraft, it is easy to damage the perspecs,
- When you land at your hunting site, **wait** for your pilot to exit the aircraft and open your door to disembark, it is important that we check skids on both sides of the aircraft are settled firmly before transferring any weight in the aircraft,
- When unloading Aircraft the pilot will hand gear to you...do not chase your dogs if they get away from you near the aircraft, carry all objects horizontally below shoulder height.
- Remember **never** walk to the back of the aircraft at any stage,
- Keep in mind you are landing in remote sites so beware of your surroundings around the aircraft, especially any rising ground; this reduces the clearance between you and the main rotor.

ON DAY OF PICK UP

- Ensure ALL your gear is secure, light objects are to be on bottom of pile, any loose clothing such as hats to be removed,
- The Pilot will load larger items first,
- The Pilot will hand you chains for your dogs, please make sure these are tight enough that you dogs are not going to slip out of them,
- Fires are to be put out well before due pick up time,
- Please bring all rubbish out with you!!! For Obvious reasons,
- If you were near maximum takeoff weight on your flight in you will need to "Bone your meat out" or you may be asked to leave some behind, if we are in your area during your stay we may call in to collect your meat and store it in our chiller, we will not make special trips to collect meat unless you are happy to pay an extra charge for this, please tell us if you wish for this to be the case prior to leaving base, keep in mind you will need to keep the camp site clear of loose items, **if we can't land we can't collect your meat.**
- Please DO NOT leave any meat around camp sites, after your hunt,
- If weather is marginal and pick up time has been and gone we will endeavour to pick you up as soon as practicable, be ready if weather seems to be clearing,

We appreciate your co-operation and remember the most important thing is that you are safe and enjoy your Hunt,
